**Reasonable fluency in English is therefore essential.**


## AIMS

## INFORMATION

The course takes place on the campus of the University of Lausanne. The campus, which is on the shores of lake Geneva, offers a wide variety of sports and other facilities. In July, music and theatre festivals take place in Lausanne and Montreux. There are a number of hotels in the vicinity of the campus (see enclosed sheet).
