Submission Deadline:

The deadline for original papers to be considered for SARAC 2020 is **September 1**st, **2019**. Please email your paper (no author information) and a separate file including author information to <u>sarac@unisg.ch</u>.

The registration deadline for SARAC 2020 is *December 15th*, 2019 with a participation fee per person of *CHF 295 (CHF 195 for PhD students/non-faculty)*. The fee covers conference access, paper downloads, coffee breaks, lunch and a conference dinner on Thursday night. Participation is limited so early registration is encouraged! Participants will need to cover their own travel and accommodation costs for which SARAC has obtained special hotel rates at both the **Radisson Blu** and **Hotel Aurora**, in Andermatt.
