Bhakti and Mukti: Literature and Liberation in Sixteenth-Century Kerala

The preponderance of textual studies of the *Bhāgavata Purāṇa* reproduce particular concerns: its theological importance to Vaiṣṇava religious communities, its philosophical influence on traditions of theistic Vedānta, and its literary reputation as the paradigmatic source of *bhaktirasa*, exemplified and exploited to the fullest by the Gauḍīya Vaiṣṇavas. In his talk, Prof. Venkatkrishnan will focus on the inverse of each: Śaivism, Advaita Vedānta, and *rasa* outside the recognized canon of bhakti. He finds evidence for each of these in the writings of Rāghavānanda (16th C.), who inherited and contributed to a regional commentarial tradition on the *Bhāgavata* in Kerala. This regional study brings to light the gaps that remain in the intellectual history of this text-tradition.
