

The 5th meeting between Science and Law in the Digital World will take stock of the impact of new technologies in the justice and health sectors.

The speakers will provide a fresh perspective on digitalisation in the justice sector and discuss the use of AI in dispute resolution and the consequences of the emergence of the metaverse. Speakers will focus on data protection in healthcare, update participants on the progress of digitalisation in the sector and discuss pressing questions, including ethical considerations.
