

How to Sign Up for the English Department Proficiency Assessment



Getting started

To sign up for a test session, you must access [Moodle](#), the university's online learning platform.

You must activate your Unil email address and your SWITCH edu-ID before you can sign up. Information about this can be found [here](#).

1. Type **moodle.unil.ch** in the address bar of your browser (Chrome, Firefox, etc.). **Do not use Internet Explorer. It might crash.**
2. Choose **AAI | SWITCHedu-ID**.



3. Select **Université de Lausanne** then click on the **select** button on the right.





4. Type in your **SWITCH edu-ID email address** in the box and then **click on continue/continuer**.



5. Type in your **password** and click on **login**.

6. You will then find yourself on your Moodle dashboard.

Under *Search courses/Rechercher des cours*, type in “**English Department Proficiency Assessment**” then click on **go/valider**.

There are two parts to this task:

1. The DIALANG proficiency test
2. A self-reflection on your English skills

These two elements provide the necessary information to plan your learning trajectory in a self-tailored and targeted manner. After discussing your results with your English Composition tutor, you will choose the modules and resources that are relevant for you and work at your own pace.

The assessment should be completed in the first two weeks of the semester. Over the course of your first year of study (and beyond), you will continue to progress with your development, by engaging with these modules and resources, in addition to your course material.
