How to Sign Up for the English Department Proficiency Assessment

Getting started

To sign up for a test session, you must access <u>Moodle</u>, the university's online learning platform.

You must activate your Unil email address and your SWITCH edu-ID before you can sign up. Information about this can be found <u>here</u>.

- 1. Type **moodle.unil.ch** in the address bar of your browser (Chrome, Firefox, etc.). **Do not use Internet Explorer. It might crash.**
- 2. Choose AAI | SWITCHedu-ID.

3. Select **Université de Lausanne** then click on the **select** button on the right.
